





Context





In 2020 the COVID-19 situation forced academic libraries to move exclusively to the Web.

The closure highlighted some of the issues the scientific community had to face:

- Lack of digitalisation of paper assets
- Inadequacy of catalogues
- Unavailability of physical collection
- Absence of information on e-books and electronic resource availability
- Problems of delivering digital documents to users
- Lack of competencies in searching and retrieving digital documents






